May 3 rd	Deadline for proposed amendments (proposed changes) to Articles in the constitution to be received in writing by the Trustee and Elections Officer for the amendments to require a 2/3 vote of the members qualified to vote, present at the AGM and voting. (Article 9.1.1). Proposed amendments submitted after this date shall require a 9/10 vote of the members qualified to vote, present and voting. (Article 9.1.2)
	This is also the deadline for proposed Bylaw changes to be received <u>in writing</u> by the Trustee and Elections Officer for the amendments to require a simple majority vote of the members qualified to vote, present at the AGM and voting. (Bylaw 20.1). Proposed amendments submitted after this date shall require a 2/3 vote of the members qualified to vote, present and voting. (Bylaw 20.2)
May 3 rd 5:00 PM	 Deadline for the submission of nominations for the positions up for election. The nominations must be in writing using and submitted to the Trustee and the Elections Officer. (Bylaw 4.2.1) Candidates must be nominated and supported by FIVE (5) other members.
